RVC Community Relations Privacy Notice

A privacy notice is a statement that discloses some, or all of the ways we as a 'Data Controller': gather, use, disclose, and manage your personal data.

What is a 'Data Controller'?

The Data Controller is the body – in this case the Royal Veterinary College (RVC) – that determines the purposes for which and the manner in which any personal data are, or are to be, processed.

What is 'personal data'?

Under UK Data Protection Law "Personal data" means any information relating to an identified or identifiable living individual. "Identifiable living individual" means a living individual who can be

Under UK Data Protection Law you have the right, subject to certain exemptions, to access the personal data that is held about you. You also have a range of further rights as follows:

- x Right of Rectification; a
- x Right or Erasure,
- x Right to be Forgotten;
- x Right to Restrict Processing;
- x Right to Data Portability;
- x Right to Object;
- x Rights in relation to Automated Decision Maaking and Profiling
