Humidity should be checked with a hygrometer placed in the middle of the vivarium and kept ~60-70%. This humidity can be achieved by frequent misting of the vivarium with water.

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Despite being mostly active at night, tree frogs appear to benefit from UV-b light. Various UV lamps are available, but for this species a lamp with a low output should be used to mimic the low-level sunlight they would be exposed to in their wild environment. Lamps should be kept on for ~ 12 hours per day and at an appropriate distance from the frog as recommended by the manufacturer.
