Duration of the Degree

The BScV eterinary Nursing degree programmetakes four years. It also includes a minimum of 1,800 hours of placements. All of these will be in the first three years of the course. Placements are compulsory and may involve additional travel costs. Please eefurther information under "Fees and Costs".

Methods of Teaching
