BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN PRE-CLINICAL VETERINARY SCIENCES

1. Title of Degree

- 1.1 The title of the degree is Bachelor of Science (BSc) in Pre Clinical Veterinary Sciences.
- 1.2 The programme for the degree is based upon a period of study in the field of veterinary medicine but does not lead to a qualification granting any form of registration to practice veterinary medicine

2. Conditions of Admission

- 2.1 The degree of BSc in Pre-Clinical Veterinary Sciences may be awarded only to internal students of The Royal Veterinary College who have transferred their registration from the degree of Bachelor of Veterinary Medicine (BVetMed). No candidate shall be registered on a course of study leading to the degree of BSc in Pre-Clinical Veterinary Sciences, except as provided for in paragraph 3.1 (v) below.
- 2.2 A student who has been awarded the BSc in Pre-Clinical Veterinary Sciences shall normally not be permitted to transfer back to the BVetMed.
- 2.3 A student who has been awarded an intercalated degree where the learning objectives overlap significantly with those of the BSc Pre-Clinical Veterinary Sciences shall not be eligible for the award of the BSc in Pre-Clinical Veterinary Sciences.

3. Award of the Degree

- 3.1 The degree of BSc in Pre-Clinical Veterinary Sciences shall be awarded by the Academic Board of The Royal Veterinary College to a candidate who satisfies all of the following criteria:
 - i) the candidate shall have been registered for the degree of BVetMed for years 1, 2 and 3.
